

Are you new to ConservationTraining.org? If so, you will want to create an account so you can access all of the great content we have available. Accounts on ConservationTraining.org are free and we will never sell or exchange your information with any other organization or company. You may receive emails from us informing you of site outages or other important information, but these emails will be rare. Let me show you how to create a new account.

From the home screen, you can click the “Sign up/Log in” tab within the top header, and then, click “Create a new account”. Before you click the create a new account button though, I’d recommend reading some of the information.

Within the new account page, you’ll need to enter your Username and Password, and then, additional details like your Email Address, your First Name and Last Name, your City and Town, Country, and also your Organization and Job Title.

Once you click “Create my new account” you will receive an email from our site with instructions on confirming your new account. You must confirm your account in order to access any of the courses.
